



Immigration Officer Selection

Written Examination

The Examination consists of 2 papers. Candidates must pass the Written Examination Paper I in order to advance to subsequent selection processes.

Paper I

Paper I is made up of a language test and an aptitude test. Time allowed for the paper is 1 hr 30 mins. The following are the tasks candidates are expected to complete for each of the test components of the language test and the aptitude test.

Language Test

English – 30 questions

- Comprehension
 - Understand the gist of a text, identify main points, draw inferences, distinguish facts from opinions, and to interpret figurative language.
 - Presentation format can vary, but usually it is text followed by questions or instructions.
- Cloze
 - Fill in blanks in a passage.
 - Multiple choice.
- Error identification
 - Identify error segments of a sentence by choosing from given options.
 - Multiple choice.

Chinese – 30 questions

- Comprehension
 - Same as English Comprehension above.
- Word usage
 - Complete sentences by choosing the most context-appropriate words or phrases.
 - Multiple choice.
- Word knowledge
 - Discriminate the meanings of homophones by choosing from options.
 - Multiple choice.
- Sentence analysis
 - Discriminate the meanings of sentences of structures or make logical inferences.
 - Multiple choice.

Aptitude Test – 30 questions

- Verbal reasoning
 - Decide whether a set of statements about a given passage is true, false, or indeterminate.
 - Multiple choice.
- Data sufficiency
 - Decide whether a question can be answered based on deductions from a set of statements.
 - Multiple choice.
- Interpretation of tables and graphs
 - Make inferences based on quantitative information provided in tables or graphs.
 - Multiple choice.
