Setup Guide for Android device

Connecting to "eduroam"

a) On the home screen, press "Apps".



b) Find the "Settings" icon and tap on it.



Turn on "Wi-Fi" function inside "Settings" and tag on it to list all the available wi-fi networks.



c) Find and select "eduroam".



- d) Select or enter the following network information:
 - Select "PEAP" in the "EAP method" option
 - Select "MSCHAPV2" in the "Phase 2 authentication" option
 - Leave the "CA certificate" option as "(unspecified)"

(Remark: Some newly Android version must select the CA certificate, please select "<u>Use system certificates</u>", then fill-in the Domain "<u>cityu.edu.hk</u>")



• Leave the "User certificate" option as "(unspecified)"
