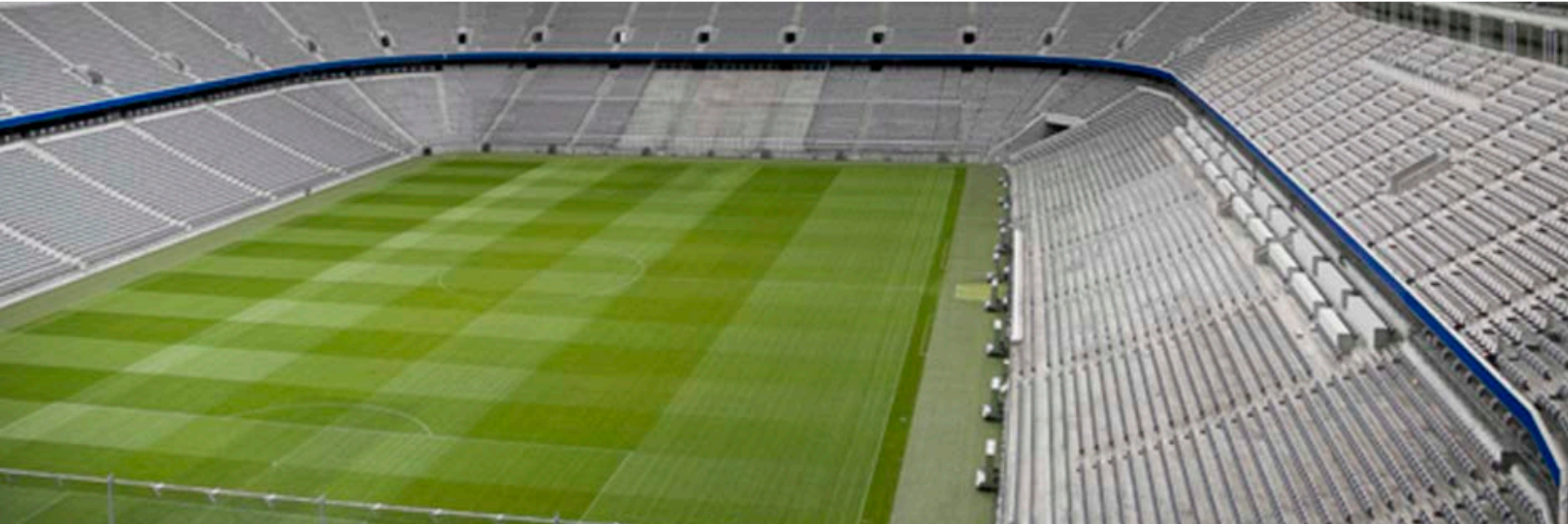

It combines both the theoretical aspects of sport, from psychological, sociological and communication perspectives with the lived experiences of students' everyday lives from both a cultural and society perspective.



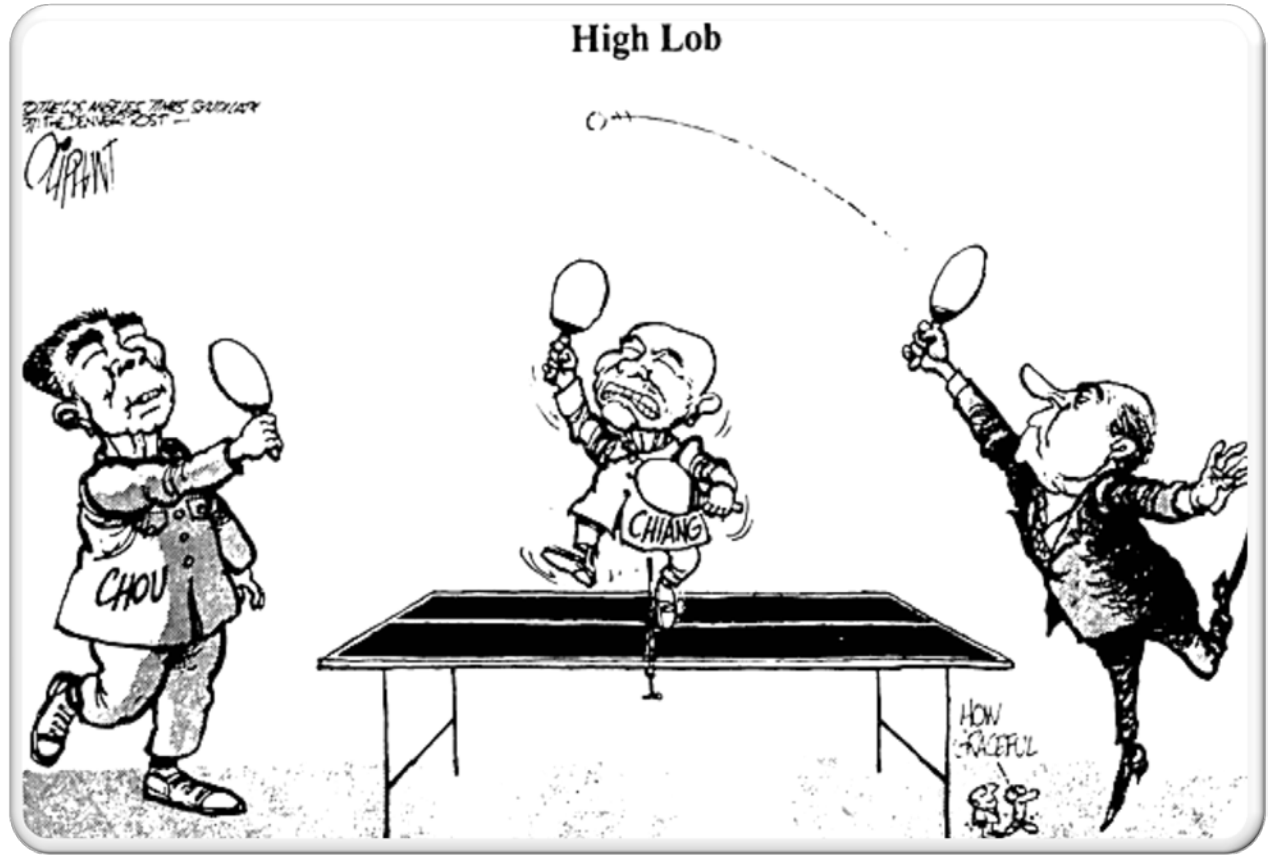

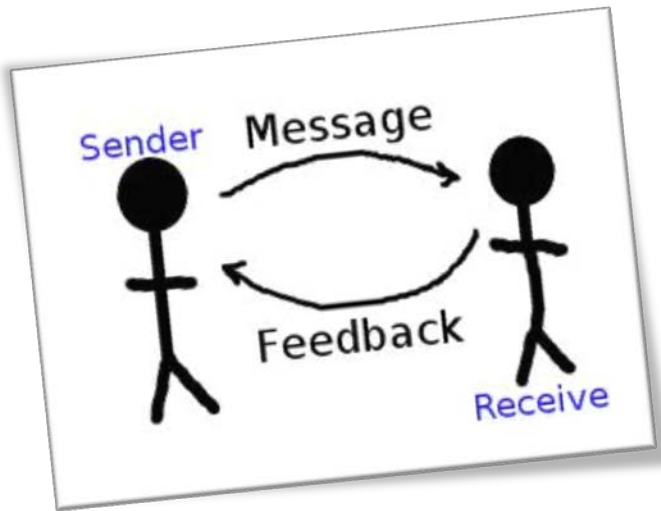
