

Recommendation on Suspension of Orientation Camps

Dear students and colleagues,

The recent updates indicate an upward trend of confirmed and suspected cases of Influenza A/H1N1 among the participants of orientation camps organized by the student societies. Upon the recommendation of the Young Chung Yee Health Centre, the University strongly advises that:

- All new students **NOT** to participate in the orientation camp activities, and
- All orientation camp organizers to **SUSPEND** their orientation camp programmes

The University has repeatedly stressed the importance of abiding by the safety guidelines on the prevention of spread of Influenza A/H1N1 to orientation camp organizers. We will continue to monitor the situation closely. Let's work together to safeguard our health and ensure a hygienic and pleasant environment for the University community.
