Introduction

The Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Post-secondary Students (NLSPS) is established by the government to complement the Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-Secondary Students (FASP) to meet students' tuition fees, academic expenses and basic living expenses. The Scheme is operated on a no-gain-no-loss and cost recovery basis. Interest rate is subject to periodic adjustment. Students eligible for assistance under FASP are eligible for NLSPS. Online Application Form (E-submission)

All NLSPS applicants are required to submit their applications through the online application form at SFO E-link – My Applications platform (<https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk>). **No more hard copy of application form can be submitted / processed.**

Submission of Declaration (paper signing selected) & Supporting Documents

Applicants should submit the signed declaration (paper signing selected) and the required supporting documents to the SFO **within 7 days** from the date of submitting the online application form through the following means:

Application Period

For Full-time Current Students: (Application deadline: 23 June 2023)

In 2023/24 academic year, NLSPS applicants should submit their applications through the online application form at SFO E-link – My Applications platform (<https://ess.wfsfaa.gov.hk>) **from 8 May 2023 to 23 June 2023.**

Please note that the earlier you hand in your application, the earlier your application will be processed and you may obtain your Non-means-tested Loan in time to cover your tuition fee for 2023/24.

Documents Required

- i) The completed NLSPS application form
- ii) Copy of your Hong Kong Identity (HKID) Card
- iii) Copy of your Student Identity card
- iv) Copy of your bank book's first page or statement showing your name and account number
- v) Copy of document showing your name and your pursuing programme for the 2023/24 academic year
- vi) Copy of transaction advice or account deposit form for the administrative fee payment **(HK\$180)** [△]

[△] The original copy of transaction advice or account deposit form for the administrative fee payment **should be submitted together with the loan documents and the required documents to the SFO upon acceptance of the NLSPS loans.**

NOTE

Full-time students of self-financing programme who wish to apply for both FASP and NLSPS have to submit the FASP and NLSPS application forms separately.
