## Southeast Asia Funding Support

Southeast Asian scholars from regional institutions may be eligible for travel and accommodation support from SEARC. To be considered as eligible, scholars must (a) be Southeast Asian citizens based at a Southeast Asian university, (b) submit a full paper in the quality and style of the SEARC Working paper series, <a href="http://www.cityu.edu.hk/searc/Publications">http://www.cityu.edu.hk/searc/Publications</a> SEARCWorkingPapers.aspx>, (c) that the paper have not been published elsewhere and that the author/s agrees to have their paper published in the SEARC Working Paper series, and (d) fully participate in the conference.

The final level of support will depend on how many eligible scholars apply. Reimbursement will only be after the conference is over. Southeast Asia is defined as the ten countries in ASEAN.
