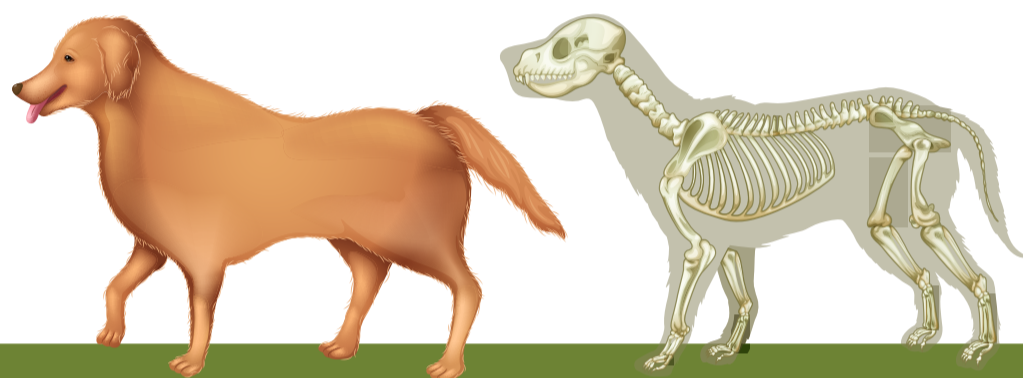

# Veterinary radiology case interpretation: Using cases to learn important principles of interpretation

In this session, cases will be used to illustrate the important principles of radiology interpretation, including the description of location, margins, number, opacity, shape and size of the lesion. In addition, classical examples and rare cases will be discussed.

1. Will be able to understand the importance of basic principles of descriptions of lesions.
2. Will be able to use the basic principles of description of lesions in clinical cases.
3. Will be able to formulate a meaningful differential diagnosis using the information from the lesion descriptions.

Dr. Heng is currently the section head of diagnostic imaging at Purdue University's College of Veterinary Medicine. Dr. Heng earned his DVM degree at the Universiti Pertanian Malaysia in 1993 and later completed his MVS degree at the University of Melbourne, Australia. From there, he moved to the United States to complete his residency and MS degree at the Colorado State University College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences in 2004. Dr. Heng then returned to the Universiti Pertanian Malaysia as a lecturer before joining the Purdue Veterinary Medicine faculty in 2007. Dr. Heng also became a Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging in 2004 and a Diplomate of the American College of Veterinary Radiology in 2005. Dr. Heng's research interests include ultrasounds of the gastrointestinal tract, forensic radiology, imaging of neoplasia, and imaging of orthopedic diseases.
