

## LLB Programme Structure (for students admitted from 2022)

LLB required courses: 54 CUs; Four PCLL pre-requisites as electives: 12 CUs (These pre-requisites aim to prepare students to be eligible for applying to the Postgraduate Certificate in Laws (PCLL) Programme); Gateway Education courses\*: min 21 CUs, max 30 CUs; One course for fulfilling the internship/consultancy project/research project requirement^: 3 or 6 CUs; and free courses (Minor and/or law electives): min 18 CUs, max 30 CUs = 120 credit units in total.

\*Gateway Education (30 credit units)

Students are required to take 30 credit units of GE courses in the 4-year curriculum:

(1) University Requirements: 9 credit units

GE English (1): GE 1401 University English (3 credit units)

GE English (2): Discipline-specific English (3 credit units)

GE1501 Chinese Civilisation – History and Philosophy (3 credit units)

(2) Distributional Requirements: 12 credit units from 3 areas (minimum 3 credit units from each area)

Area 1: Arts and Humanities

Area 2: Study of Societies, Social and Business Organizations

Area 3: Science and Technology
