Ms Chau is a Certified Public Accountant. She has been working at Ernst & Young for over 20 years and has been a partner since 2002. She served on the Committee of the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) Hong Kong from 1998 to 2008 and was President in 2006/07. She was actively involved in providing technical training for the development of ACCA members and student members, and mentorship programmes for accounting undergraduates in various universities.

Ms Chau is a supportive alumna who contributes to the development of her alma mater in different capacities. She is currently Member of the Court of the University and the Advisory Committee of School of Continuing and Professional Education, and Honorary Treasurer of CityU Eminence Society, an alumni association formed by senior alumni of CityU. Previously she served as a Member of the Council of the University from 2007 to 2010. CityU conferred a Distinguished Alumni Award on Ms Chau in 2011.
