Ms Chea is an experienced and respected broadcaster in Hong Kong, having hosted countless highly-rated programmes covering music and news to entertainment and parenting. She was awarded “The Most Favourable DJ” (disc jockey) eight years in a row, and is a recipient of the “Ten Outstanding Young Persons” award.

In addition to her busy career, she has developed a harmonious and loving family with her husband Cheung Man-sun, Assistant Director (Radio & Corporate Programming) of Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK). They have raised two children who have demonstrated distinguished academic performances. Their elder son graduated from the University of Pennsylvania with First Honours, majoring in economics and psychology. He scored over 3.6 in GPA and 3A5B in the HKCEE. Their daughter graduated from an environmental engineering science programme at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). She scored 5A4B in the HKCEE. The University of Pennsylvania and MIT are ranked at 9th and 3rd in the world respectively. Ms Chea is gratified with their achievements and feels immensely proud of them. In the eyes of her children, she is not only their mother but also a mentor and their best friend.

While enjoying her “semi-retirement” life since 2010, Ms Chea still hosts the long-running programme 「舊日的足跡」 on RTHK every Sunday, interviewing celebrities of diverse backgrounds.
