ABSTRACT:

We discuss some turning point theory techniques to derive asymptotics of q polynomials around their largest zeros, between the zeros (oscillatory rang), and beyond the largest zero. We survey the turning point theory for differential equations then introduce our new technique which only uses the functional equations satisfied by the polynomials and does not use refined. This is based on joint work with Chun-Kong Law.
